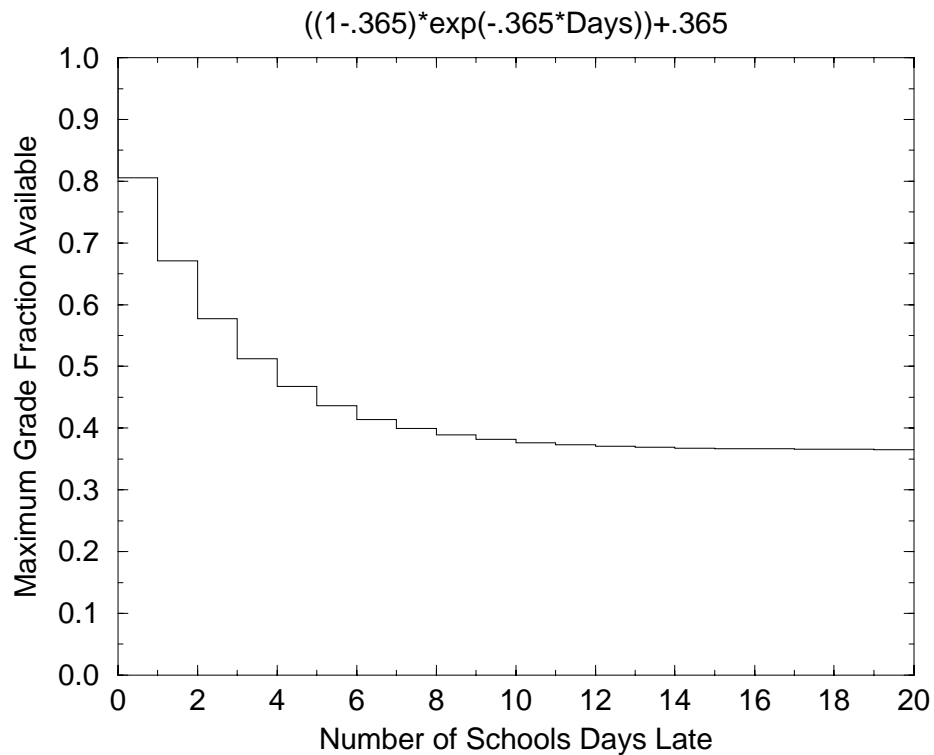

$$M = (1 - .365)e^{(-.365D)} + .365$$
